ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURES

All participants must arrive on Sunday, 23rd June and depart on Thursday, 27th June 2019. Please provide us with your *flight details* along with your *registration number* (given to you on your official invitation letter) before **Monday, 17th June 2019** to ensure timely airport transportation. For those who have updated us, we thank you for your prompt cooperation. Kindly note that there will be buses and vans taking you from Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) to La Boss Hotel in Melaka, scheduled at several trips in morning, afternoon and evening sessions. Kindly choose and take a trip that is the closest time to your flight detail. For smooth execution, please make sure, that you inform us promptly about your arrival time.

Late confirmation may not allow us to receive you at the airport.

AIRPORT PICKUP

International participants will be picked up from both airports, the Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) and the Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) 2 and transported to the venue in La Boss Hotel, Melaka, Malaysia.

MIYD Organising Committee will be waiting for you at the arrival hall, after customs and immigration, with a welcome placard with WAY and MIYD logo. You are advised not to move to the arrival hall too quickly, as you may miss the placard. Local participants, i.e. those residing in Malaysia, will need to make their own way to the meeting venue or meet the organising committee at KLIA. If you are lost or need any assistance please contact the emergency contact numbers of the transport personnel given below.

REGISTRATION FEE

All foreign participants are required to pay a registration fee of U\$200 and all local participants (resident in Malaysia) should pay MYR900. This fee can be paid in advance or at the MIYD venue. Only registered participants with confirmation letters issued will be allowed to attend this dialogue.

ACCOMMODATION, FOOD AND LOCAL TRANSPORT

All participants will be accommodated in twin-sharing basis in all cases at La Boss Hotel, Melaka.

Participants who want to upgrade to single-occupancy rooms should pay an **additional** U\$200 for the period of 23rd to 27th June 2019.

Also, for those arriving early or departing late, an additional fee of U\$50 per standard room **per night** will apply. The hotel contact details and map are indicated at the end of this document.

Food shall be provided according to the prescribed menu. Provisions will be made for those needing vegetarian, Halal or any other special food. Kindly notify us upon registering at the MIYD venue.

WAY will cater for the accommodation, food and local transportation for all accredited participants.

IMMIGRATION AND BAGGAGE CLEARANCE

All participants are responsible in securing their visa to Malaysia before travelling. The official invitation letter issued by WAY to each participant registered has to be brought along to ensure the smooth immigration clearance. For those participants travelling from countries where the yellow fever card is required, kindly refer to Healthcare section as follow.

As for the baggage clearance, all participants are responsible in ensuring that the contents of the luggage have to be free from any prohibited and/or illegal materials and/or substances. Kindly print the special logo attached and paste them in your luggage for easy and fast recognition as well as clearance.

HEALTHCARE

Vaccines and medicines¹

Please note that people from countries where the **yellow fever card** is required alongside your other travel documents should remember to bring it along. As stipulated by the Ministry of Health of Malaysia, failure to present the yellow fever card, will result in a mandatory 6 days quarantine.

All travelers

You should be up to date on routine vaccinations while traveling to any destination. Some vaccines may also be required for travel.

Routine vaccines

Make sure you are up-to-date on routine vaccines before every trip. These vaccines include measles-mumps-rubella (MMR) vaccine, diphtheria-tetanus-pertussis vaccine, varicella (chickenpox) vaccine, polio vaccine, and your yearly flu shot.

Most travelers

Get travel vaccines and medicines because there is a risk of these diseases in the country you are visiting.

Hepatitis A

CDC recommends this vaccine because you can get hepatitis A through contaminated food or water in Malaysia, regardless of where you are eating or staying.

Typhoid

You can get typhoid through contaminated food or water in Malaysia. CDC recommends this vaccine for most travelers, especially if you are staying with friends or relatives, visiting smaller cities or rural areas, or if you are an adventurous eater.

DRESS CODE

Formal clothing is recommended throughout the event. During the event and cultural performances, as stated in the agenda, national costume may also be worn. It is suggested to wear casual for the tours and field trips.

The weather is expected to be warm, humid, and sunny throughout the period of the MIYD, as it can be regularly expected in Malaysia. Warm clothing may be required for indoors, which will be air-conditioned and therefore sometimes it can be chilly.

CURRENCY

The Malaysian Ringgit (MYR) is the official currency of Malaysia. This is pegged at the rate of 4.2 to one US dollar. If you are bringing foreign currency, it is recommended you bring US dollars, Euro, British Pounds or other major currencies which will be accepted and easily changed.
