ABOUT THE VENUE

AUYA venue is at Hotel Hatten, Melaka, which is at a distance of 160 km from the Kuala Lumpur International Airport. It takes approximately one and half hours to reach the hotel from the airport. The venue is in close proximity to the heritage quarter in Melaka. The Independence Memorial is at a distance of 200m, so is the Stadthuys built in the 1650 by the Dutch. The iconic A' Famosa, a Portuguese fortress built in 1511 is also a short walk away from the venue. A 10 minute walk will take you to the picturesque Melaka River.
